Then install the downloaded rpm:

```
cd ~/Downloads  
sudo yum install ./zoom_x86_64.rpm
```

After, run 'zoom' to create your local config file. Then edit file to allow zoomgov:

```
zoom # then close it.
```

```
sed -i 's/enableCloudSwitch=false/enableCloudSwitch=true/' ~/.config/zoomus.conf
```

```
zoom # Zoom should now have zoomgov option available
```
